Prerequisites

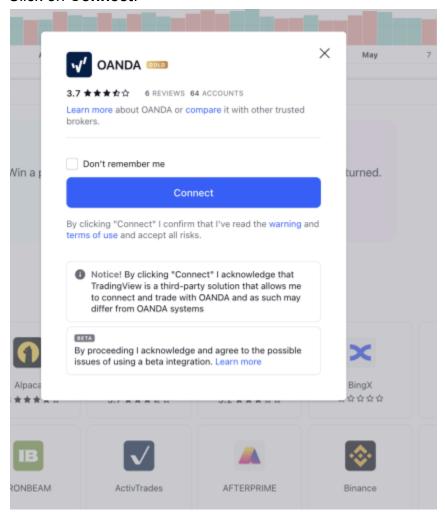
- 1. You must have a TradingView account.
- 2. You must have an OANDA live account.

How to log in

- 1. Go to the <u>TradingView website</u> and log in with your TradingView account credentials.
- 2. Navigate to the OANDA broker page.
- 3. Select **TRADE** near the right-hand side of the screen.



4. Click on Connect.



- Enter your OANDA email address and password. Next, click on Sign in.
 You must ignore the Continue with one-key login and Login for OANDA EU and TMS clients options.
- 6. Go to **Products > Supercharts**.

You will notice OANDA at the bottom of the screen.



How to switch sub-accounts?

In the **Supercharts** view, at the bottom of the screen, all your demo and live sub-accounts will be listed in a dropdown list next to OANDA. You can select the sub-account you require for trading.



Which instruments can I trade on?

OANDA Corporation clients can trade on only forex instruments. Spot crypto is not available for trading on TradingView.

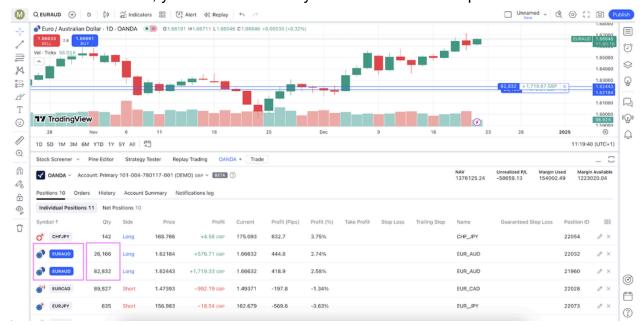
Due to system limitations, the symbols list may contain non-tradeable symbols that should be ignored. When you try to trade on non-tradeable symbols, you will notice the following message:



How can I check the history of my trades and orders?

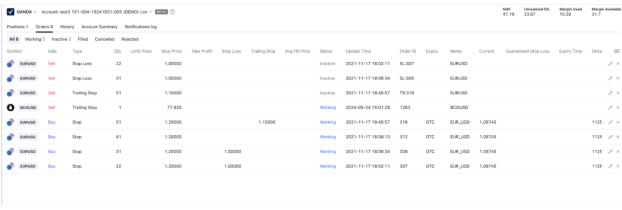
In the **Supercharts** view, at the bottom of the screen, you will notice the following options:

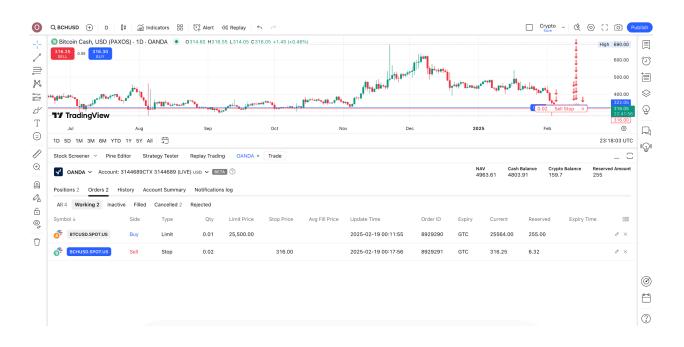
In the Positions tab, you will find a list of your individual and net positions.



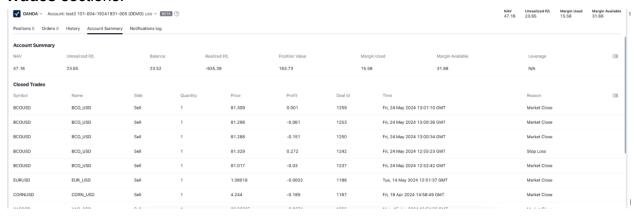

2. In the **Orders** tab, you will find a list of your orders.



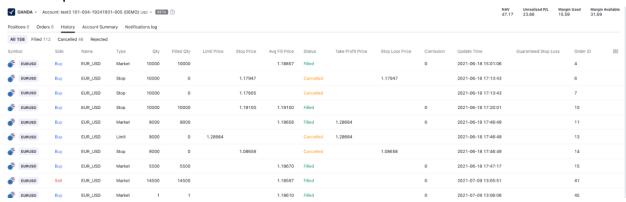


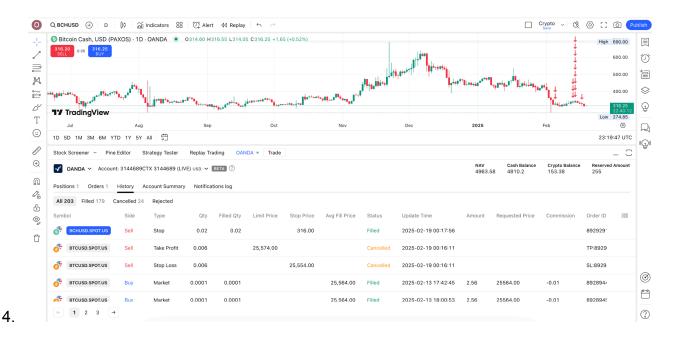
In the **Account Summary** tab, you will find the **Account Summary** and **Closed Trades** sections.

In the **History** tab, you will find sub-tabs for **All**, **Filled**, **Cancelled** and **Rejected** orders. The **History** tab does not provide information about daily financing, deposits, withdrawals and order modifications. You can find this information on OANDA platforms.





5. In the **Notifications** log, you will find recently completed transactions.

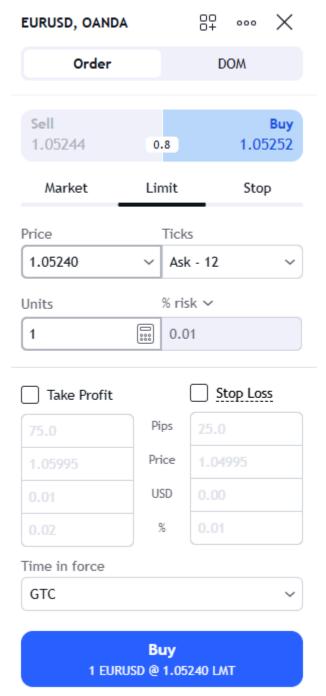
How to place an order

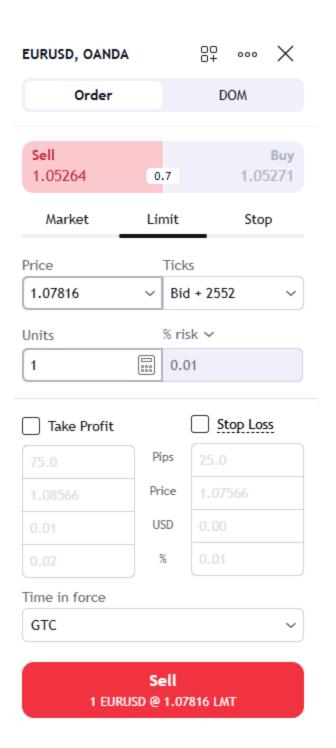
- Analyze the prices on the charts.
 Note: The prices on the charts are only indicative (not tradeable). Indicative charts show possible price trends but not actual trade or execution prices.
- 2. Right-click anywhere on the chart.
- 3. Click on Trade. Next, click on Create new order...
- 4. Alternatively, you can place an order by clicking on the **Trade** button on the panel at the bottom of the screen.



5. In a ticket order window, you can:

- a. Depending on the account type, define the number of units or lots to buy or sell.
- b. Switch between **Market**, **Limit** or **Stop** order or
- c. Assign Take Profit and Stop Loss.





- 6. Once you finish setting up your order, click on **Buy** or **Sell**.
